Re: Notice of No Parking for Street Maintenance - *Update*

The City has contracted with Jackson County to place a modified chip seal on Ridgeview Drive, Teakwood Drive, Hannon Road, and a short section of Crystal Drive at Highway 62. In order to place the chip seal, no parking will be allowed on ~~Thursday, August 18~~, **Wednesday, August 24, 2016, from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm**. Parking is allowed on all adjacent streets. In addition to this notice, barricades will be placed in the street prior to the chip seal construction. Every effort will be made to complete the maintenance work efficiently, and emergency access will be allowed at all times. Please turn off your irrigation system the morning of planned work, or check your system for overspray.

The modified chip seal is a part of the City's preventative maintenance program. Jackson County crews will crack seal and replace damaged sections of pavement the **week of August 15, 2016**. On the day of the chip seal, oil will be sprayed onto the pavement, followed by the placement of rocks or 'chips'. After the chips have settled for several days, a fog seal will be sprayed over the top to retain the rocks and restore the pavement to a black condition. Please drive slowly after the chips have been placed prior to the fog seal.
