Public Works Update – Pavement Maintenance October 21, 2019

2019 Pavement Maintenance Program

Paving of S. Buchanan Avenue and the Linn Road/Loto Street/Buchanan Avenue Intersection was completed by Knife River Materials on Monday, October 21, 2019. Although the work was scheduled to be completed by 5:30 pm, the intersection was open before 3:30 pm for school traffic.







Paving

The 2018 Pavement Management Program Budget Options Report identified several roads in “poor” and “fair” condition, based upon the pavement condition index (PCI). With the completion of S. Buchanan Avenue, all of the road segments identified as “poor” (Pavement Condition Index less than 50) have been repaved, or are currently under construction (E. Main Street/Stevens Road). There were no streets categorized as “very poor” in the 2018 report.

Rogue Valley Sewer Services (RVSS) has a project proposed for Onyx Street. The City is planning to partner with RVSS to complete the paving on Onyx Street from Tabor Avenue to N. Shasta Avenue in the spring or summer of 2020.

MicroCoat

The City is pursuing a pilot project using the MicroCoat technology. The MicroCoat provides additional treatment to the pavement beyond the typical seal coat. Eagle Point Drive and Silverado Way are the two selected test locations for the project, scheduled for summer of 2020.
