


Neighborhood Watch

BICYCLE THEFT PREVENTION



The Rogue Valley has been experiencing a high volume of bicycle thefts. Eagle Point is no exception. Please be sure to secure your bicycles in areas not accessible to the general public. Officers have reported seeing bicycles lying on lawns, driveways and along the roadway in front of houses. At some point, your bicycle may disappear.

Also, if such an unfortunate theft occurs, having documentation, serial numbers and a photograph of your bicycle will definitely assist law enforcement with its recovery.

IRS FRAUD ALERT

There has been an increase of IRS Fraud attempts across the country. Fake IRS agents are contacting people by phone, demanding payments over the phone via credit card, debit card, bank account information or wire transfer. If the victim does not comply, the caller tries to convince them that law enforcement will be called and they will be arrested. **NOT TRUE**

Real IRS agents usually contact people first by mail, and they never demand payment by debit card, credit card or wire transfer. If you receive a call from someone claiming to be an IRS agent, do not give your account(s) information over the phone. Please contact and make a report with your police department via the non-emergency dispatch number 541-776-7206.
