

Project Update – Stevens Road Improvements

January 10, 2020

East Main Street/Stevens Road Improvements

Knife River Materials continued construction of the sidewalks.





Limits of Project Construction



Street signs were installed on the project.



Light pole bases were completed, and flag pole inserts installed approximately every 25 feet for the Avenue of the Flags.



A drivable curb was designed and installed as a new potential detail for Eagle Point. The curb allows for RV access, but also provides for street sweeping and most drainage applications. The curb is a full curb, and does not prohibit on street parking. The detail will be investigated for retrofit of existing properties over the next year.



Construction of the ADA ramps continued.



Construction of the water quality structures.



Construction of the Nazarene Church (Church on the Hill) access began by AMPs as a separate project. The concrete driveway was completed by Knife River. Including this access as part of the original project would have delayed the overall Stevens Road construction by 6-8 months.

Look Ahead

Construction will continue through January and February of 2020, with one-lane traffic control during the day to install the remaining sidewalks and light standards. In late January, light standards are scheduled to be installed, with full lighting anticipated by the middle of February. The contract date for completion of the full project is April of 2020. Knife River Materials is currently ahead of the contract date for completion.

Over the next few months, two driveway connections will be completed, and a mailbox center installed near the beginning of the project. A separate project has been initiated to construct ADA ramps at Robert Trent Jones Boulevard and Stevens Road.
